Education:

Graduated in 2007 at the Faculty of Economics in Subotica, Department of Financial Management and Accounting. He earned his master degree in 2009 at the Faculty of Economics in Subotica, Department of Accounting and Auditing. In 2009, he enrolled in doctoral studies at the Faculty of Economics in Subotica, in the field of Economics – Finance module. He defended his doctoral dissertation titled *"The Spillover Effects of Financial Shocks on Stock and Foreign Exchange Markets in Selected Emerging Economies"* on September 20, 2016, at the Faculty of Economics in Subotica, thereby obtaining the academic title of Doctor of Economic Sciences.

Professional experience:

Since October 2007, he has been employed at the College of Applied Business Studies in Novi Sad. He initially held the position of Teaching Associate, and upon enrolling in doctoral studies, he was appointed as an Assistant in the field of finance in January 2010. After earning his doctorate, he was appointed as a Lecturer in the field of economics. In November 2021, he was promoted to Professor of Applied Studies in the field of finance. Due to his demonstrated scientific achievements, he met the requirements to be appointed as a Research Associate on April 22, 2019, upon the recommendation of the Institute of Agricultural Economics in Belgrade. On January 29, he was promoted to Senior Research Associate, also upon the recommendation of the Institute of Agricultural Economics. As of May 1, 2025, he has been employed at the Institute of Agricultural Economics in Belgrade.

Scientific activity:

His areas of interest include international finance, financial econometrics, macroeconomics, and portfolio analysis. To date, he has published 70 papers in international journals indexed in the SSCI list. Additionally, his work has been cited in over 200 papers, and his h-index is 11 (according to the SCOPUS database).
